## A Brief History of the School

The 2nd Senior High School of Eleftherio-Kordelio began operating in September 1999.

Its facilities include a separate Gymnasium building as well as a small structure, donated by the Prefecture of Thessaloniki, which originally served as a guardhouse. With the opening of the school, laboratories for Physics and Informatics were organized, along with the school Library.

In addition, programs were planned and implemented in Environmental Education, Health Education, and Consumer Education, with topics such as:

- a) Urban environment: streets, parks, entertainment centers of Eleftherio-Kordelio
- b) Aspects of modern Greek society through classic Greek cinema
- c) Aerobic exercise
- d) Household consumption – household waste

Indicatively, up to the present day, the school has received various awards, such as:






# Mustafapaşa Ortaokulu


# CIP TAFALLA (SPAIN)


# **“ALEXANDRU IOAN CUZA” NATIONAL COLLEGE PLOIESTI, ROMANIA**

# **II Liceum Ogólnokształcące im Jana Śniadeckiego w Kielcach**

It was founded in 1903 as a private, seven-grade Municipal Commercial School. During the Russian partition, Poles were not prohibited from establishing commercial schools, so the residents of Kielce voluntarily contributed taxes to establish a Polish-language school. During World War I, a hospital operated in its building. In 1918, it was transformed into the Boys' Real School, and then into the eight-year Jan Śniadecki State Gymnasium. In 1932, as a result of a reform, the school was divided into a four-year gymnasium and a two-year high school. During the occupation, its building was converted into a grain warehouse. In 1945, the school reopened, but after five years, it was closed for ideological reasons. The Second High School for Girls was then established in its building. It was not until 1958 that the school resumed operations in its previous form, this time as the Second High School for Girls.
